St. Matthew Catholic Secondary School to Relocate in 2019

Kemptville, ON (Thursday, October 25, 2018) – The Catholic District School Board of Eastern Ontario is pleased to announce that the Board will be moving forward with a plan to move students from the existing St. Matthew Catholic Secondary School located at 822 Marlborough Street North in Cornwall, to a new location in the former St. Columban's Catholic School located at 323 Augustus Street. The school will move into the newly renovated facility for the 2019-2020 school year, with renovations commencing in January 2019.

The relocation will bring about some enhanced learning opportunities for students, with greater access to specialized programs such as Construction, Hospitality and Hairstyling. The facility also offers a fully equipped gymnasium and an expanded grade 7 and 8 program. The more central location will promote better partnerships with the Cornwall community, as well as easier access to public transportation for students.

Superintendent of School Effectiveness Natalie Cameron is pleased that the project is moving forward.
