DAY 3

READING

The "Letter of the Day" is "S" for "super"! Go for a walk and try to point out signs or items that have the letter "S" in them. As you're walking collect 2-3 small rocks for today's writing activity.

WRITING

All across the world, children are painting rocks with hopeful messages and placing them around their neighbourhoods to cheer people up while they go for walks. Together with your child, paint your rocks with encouraging messages, trying to use "S" words as

DAY 1

READING

The "Letter of the Day" is "A" for "awesome"!
As a family go on a scavenger hunt (inside or outside) to find signs that include the letter "A".

WRITING

Write a letter to a friend or loved one you haven't been able to visit with lately.
After the letter is completed, count how many "As" you included. Parents are encouraged to help!

DAY 4

READING

Today's "Letter of the Day" is the first letter of your child's name. Play a game of "catch and each time someone drops the ball, they have to say a word that starts with that letter.

WRITING

Today is all about celebrating your child!
Together, write a silly story about an adventure your child wants to go on. (ex: "Johnny's Jump to Jupiter")

DAY 2

READING

The "Letter of the Day" is "H" for "happiness"!
Have children complete a scavenger hunt by finding 2 outdoor items that bring them happiness.

WRITING

Working together, have your child complete an acrostic poem for the word "HAPPY". (ex: H is for hugs, A is for awesome, etc.)

DAY 5

READING

Today's "Letter of the Day" is "F" for "Friday"! Go for a nature walk, collecting sticks, stones, leaves, etc. along the way. Once home, use your nature items to create the letter "F" in both lower and upper case.

WRITING

Break out newspapers, magazines, or flyers and have your child cut out letters and phrases to make a list of "Fun Friday" activities that they love to do.
