- 1. **Prayer & Welcome** Norma. Reflection on the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary (May 31<sup>st</sup>). Reading from Gospel of Luke 1:39-45. Prayer Hail Mary.
- 2. Review Meeting Minutes from May 1, 2019 -
  - Follow up items from May 1st meeting:
    - 1. PIC members attend welcome back events in September at all schools. <u>Katy Ferguson and Julie Marshall volunteered to create a one page, point form, speaking notes for PIC members to use at all school September welcome back events.</u>
    - 2. Catholic Education Coalition Events feedback
      - a. <u>More involvement of Catholic School Council</u> <u>members and PIC members in CEC planning</u>.
      - b. CEC events must be offered at a time when parents can attend. Not during the day. Cornwall concert is an evening event which is well supported by parents. Relay for Life in Perth is also supported by parents and community as it runs until 11pm. Please consider providing same evening opportunities for Leeds/Grenville and Prescott-Russell schools.
    - 3. May 1<sup>st</sup> electronic meeting feedback <u>nice option</u> for one of our four meetings per year. Suggested using this format for the winter meeting. It is difficult to join the conversation as there is a delay in hearing the speaker which makes jumping into the conversation awkward.
