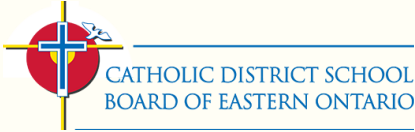

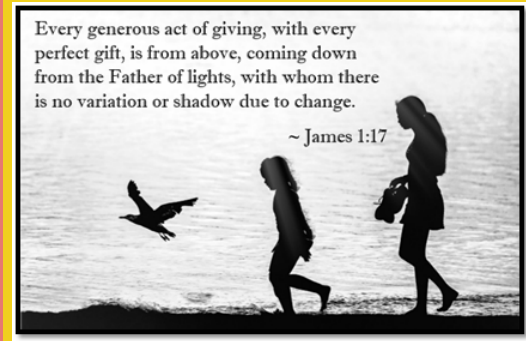
WRITING

Six Word Stories

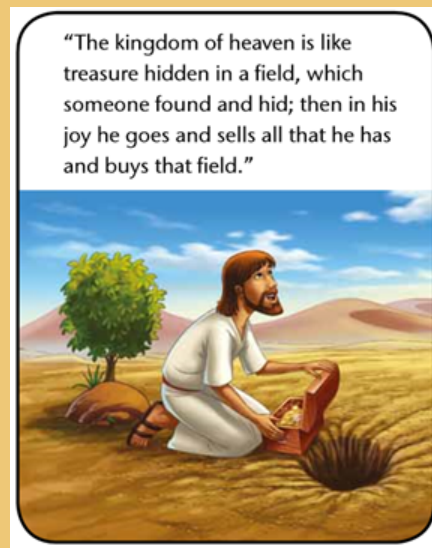
WRITING
