1. Purpose:

A student of compulsory school age may be excused from attendance at school if may be excused from attendance at school if receiving satisfactory instruction at home or elsewhere.¹

2. Procedure

- 1) The principal will meet with the parent/guardian to:
 - a) explain the Home Schooling ² Procedures and ensure that all alternatives, including remaining at school have been explored,
 - b) provide, and have parent complete, the "Notification of Intent to Provide Home Schooling" Form
 - Inform the parent to send the completed, signed form to the appropriate Supervisory Officer
 - Information. Inform the parent that if they decide to provide home schooling in subsequent years, they should give notification each year in writing (i.e. completing and submitting another Notification of Intent to Provide Home Schooling" Form prior to September 1st to the school board in whose jurisdiction their child last attended school.
 - Notify the Board of a change in address information.
 - c) Make the parent aware of the following minimal expectations pertaining to satisfactory instruction.
 - Develop a plan that identifies timelines for instruction and assessing the child(ren)'s achievement.
 - Develop a plan which ensures instruction of literacy and numeracy components at the developmentally appropriate levels.

² <u>Home Schooling</u> – a student is excused from attendance at school if receiving satisfactory instruction at home or elsewhere. Home Schooling is a result of parent/guardian choice to remove the student from the school and parent/guardian provides instruction for the student.

- 2) The superintendent of education will acknowledge, in writing, the request for home schooling with appropriate reference to the legislation.
- 3) The principal will:
 - a) retire the student from the school register with the explanation: "home schooling", effective as of the date of the letter of acknowledgement from the superintendent of schools,
 - b) attach home schooling information to the school enrolment binder.
 - c) Ensure the Ontario Student Record is maintained at the last school attended and contains the information in 2. 1) b).
- 4) Upon re-entry to the system, the principal (elementary and secondary³) will:
 - a) follow the regular procedure for admission
 - b) determine student placement/program on an age-appropriate basis⁴ (elementary)
 - c) Where appropriate apply sections 6.6 and 6.7.2 and appendix 8, "Equivalent Diploma Requirements", of <u>Ontario Secondary Schools</u>, Grades 9 to 12 Program and Diploma Requirements, 1999 (OSS)
