The Catholic District School Board of Eastern Ontario serves eight (8) counties in the region including Lanark, Leeds, Grenville, Dundas, Stormont, Glengarry, Prescott and Russell Counties. The Board's jurisdiction covers an area of 12,165 square kilometres and includes 39 elementary and 10 secondary schools, including adult and alternative education programs. The Board provides Catholic education to more than 13,000 students and employs approximately 1,500 teachers and support staff.

The Director of Education reports to seven (7) Trustees and one (1) Student Trustee. As per the Education Act, the Director of Education serves as the Secretary of the Board.

The Board of Trustees are seeking an individual with a proven track record of results combining Supervisory Officer papers with a Master's degree and leadership experience working within the public education sector, with demonstrated acumen in financial accountability in a medium to large organization. The individual should have demonstrated outstanding leadership at the local and provincial level. The Director should have excellent communication skills and have demonstrated a commitment to the Gospel values and the teachings of Christ and the Catholic Church.
