Teaching Learning and Innovation Allocation

CDSBEO Trustees were presented with an update on the Teaching Learning and Innovation Allocation (TLIA) from Principal of Curriculum Brenda Reil. TLIA funding is provided to Ontario school boards to implement special learning projects which align with Ministry priorities such as equity, Indigenous Education, STEM, and student mental health.

Five CDSBEO schools were provided with funding after project proposals were submitted. The goal was to enhance learning capacity in areas throughout the Board, and special consideration was given to funding teams with project proposals that could be shared systemwide, as well as innovative projects that improved student engagement. The TLIA fund enabled CDSBEO to support teacher collaboration, responsive learning, and the sharing of effective teaching and learning practices within schools.
